Planning is underway for a great week at West Coast Honor Camp. Camp will be held at Lassen Pines Retreat Center, east of Redding, California the week of **June 20- June 26, 2010**. Camp will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Prospective campers must be entering 6th grade or higher in the fall of 2010. Sixth grade campers must be 10 years old & High School campers must be 13 years old by September 30, 2010. First time campers who have been in the 5th - 8th Grade clubs less than 2 years must have completed 1 Handbook/Manual before the first day of camp. Those who have been in the 5th – 8th Grade clubs for 2 or more years must complete 2 or more Handbooks/Manuals (earned an Excellence Award) before the first day of camp. High School campers must have completed their current year's Awana Journey 24/7 requirements including the required Bible reading, training conference, elective manual and Christian service. Returning campers must complete an additional handbook/manual each year.

Honor Camp is planned just for those special award-earning clubbers in the Northern California & Northern Nevada region. Your efforts with these young people through the club year can be crowned with the lasting impact of one week at West Coast Honor Camp. Camp provides an opportunity to help you achieve your ministry goals. The positive environment and concentrated Bible teaching help clubbers and teens to make important decisions for Christ that will last a lifetime.

The host camp has many activities and facilities that young people enjoy. Anticipated activities include boating, fishing, ping-pong, go-carts, handcrafts, paintball (permission slip required), and more. All campers will participate in scripture memorization and challenging Bible studies written especially for their age group.

A Non-refundable, Non-transferable Application Deposit of \$75 is due with the camper application. This Deposit will hold a spot in camp for your child until the final payment deadline. The balance of camp fees must be postmarked by **May 1, 2010 to receive the Early Bird discount.** If there are no openings, all fees (including the deposit) will be returned. Fees do not include transportation to or from camp or spending money for snacks or the above noted activities. Included in the camp fees: one team t-shirt (designed just for West Coast Honor Camp), all study materials and a camp picture. Cancellations made prior to two weeks before camp will receive a refund minus the \$75.00 deposit. Refunds for cancellations after that time may only be approved on a case-by-case basis for extreme situations. **All fees must be paid in full by May 15, 2010. All applications postmarked after May 15, 2010 must include full payment.**

Please read and complete the camper application carefully. Incomplete applications cannot be processed until all information has been received and will be returned to the applicant for completion. We have instituted an "Early Bird" pricing structure for those campers that have their camp fees paid in full by the May 1st due date. The camp fee schedule is found at the bottom of this page.

West Coast Honor Camp uses qualified adult Awana Leaders as counselors. Awana leaders interested in applying for various staff positions should contact your local Awana Commander or the camp website at www.westcoasthonorcamp.com. We will need over 50 counselors to care for the expected 350 campers. We challenge you to come and spend a week with these award-earning clubbers and achieving teens.

Begin immediately to encourage all achievers from your club and teen programs to join us for a never-to-be-forgotten experience at Honor Camp.

Dear Parents of Campers,

At West Coast Honor Camp (WCHC), we care about kids! Our hope and prayer is that all children and youth throughout the world will come to know, love and serve the Lord Jesus Christ.

We also care about the safety and protection of your child. Our objective is to protect children and youth from anything that is inappropriate or harmful. To do this, we need your help. Please talk to your child about things that are inappropriate for them. Here are some examples:

- Hazing or initiations
- Adults asking them for favors
- Adults or children pressuring them to do things that are wrong
- Any person touching them inappropriately
- Anyone showing them inappropriate pictures

Give your child permission to talk to you about anything in his or her camp experience that made them feel uncomfortable. Let your son or daughter know anything can be discussed with a camp counselor or the Camp Director should there be something he or she is not comfortable with at camp.

Volunteers for WCHC are chosen carefully. They are screened by the Camp Director, have gone through an extensive application process, background checks, as well as having positive references. Our expectation is that all volunteers will have a positive spiritual impact on children attending camp.

Should you have any concerns regarding anything that occurred at camp, you may contact the West Coast Honor Camp Board of Directors and speak with any one of the Directors regarding the matter. The contact information is at the end of this letter.

We fully expect that camp will be a positive experience for all children. We expect that camp will be a time of spiritual growth and a time your child will look back on with fond memories. We covet your prayers as we work to bring spiritual enrichment to the young people that are entrusted to us at camp.

West Coast Honor Camp Code of Conduct

1. I will honor God with all my actions and attitudes at camp.
 2. I will respect others and value them while at camp.
 3. I will show respect to my counselors and others in authority while at camp.
 4. I will respect the camp property.
 5. I will obey the Lassen Pines Retreat Center rules.
 6. I will set a good example for those around me while at camp.
 7. I will follow the rules and guidelines for activities at camp.
 8. I will not gossip or use my tongue to cut down others.
 9. I will not bring excessive jewelry or inappropriate clothing (too tight, too short or too offensive) to camp.
 10. I will commit to reading my Bible and having daily devotions while at camp.
 11. I will, in good faith, enter into the spirit of camp, not just following the rules but praying that God will use every experience to shape and mold my life.
 12. I understand that attendance at camp is a privilege and that I may be sent home at any time for failing to meet the terms of this agreement.
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Dress Code

West Coast Honor Camp, being a Christian camp, is operated according to scriptural standards. Therefore, counselors and campers are expected to exercise discretion and modesty regarding clothing. A Christian's testimony is impacted and may offend others by the choice of clothing or the way it is worn. Outfits that are too tight, too loose, or too short may appear provocative. The following dress code will be strictly enforced.

Girls/Women Counselors

- Halter-tops, spaghetti straps, and bare midriffs are not allowed.
- There will be no skin showing between pants and shirt.
- Tops and pants must be loose fitting.
- Short shorts, mini dresses or short skirts are not allowed.
- Swimsuits are to be modest with no plunging necklines or high cut leg openings. No skin showing between top and bottom.
- Swimwear must be covered with a shirt & shorts at all times except while on the beach.
- Do not wear tops that reveal your underwear, or lack thereof.
- "Low rise" pants or shorts are not allowed.
- Shorts length must be modest, not too short. Mid-thigh is the best guideline.

Guys/Men Counselors

- "Sagging" is not allowed at camp. Bring a belt.
- Shirts must be worn at all times except while swimming, showering, or when in your cabin.
- Jewelry above the neck is not allowed.

Everyone

- Shoes or sandals must be worn at all times--except in the shower or cabin. Do not go barefoot on the way to the lake.
- Athletic (closed toe) shoes must be worn for activities
- Body piercing jewelry is not allowed. .
- Do not bring any shirts, hats, etc., which contain advertising that would not be honoring to God.

Your Counselor and Camp Staff will be the final authority regarding the suitability of clothing and adherence to this policy. If attire is unacceptable you will be required to modify your dress. Following the dress code with no argument is expected of all campers.

Medication Procedures

Dear Campers and Parents,

We are looking forward to an exciting week as we share with you what God has planned. In order to make sure that we meet your needs in regards to any medication you may require during camp, please adhere to the following guidelines:

All medications must be taken to the nurse's station at check-in time. This includes pills, liquids, inhalers, creams, vitamins and any dietary or herbal supplements.

Prescription Medications:

- 1) Must be in their original container with the instruction portion clearly seen.
- 2) Will only be given *as prescribed* and if not outdated. Please check expiration dates and dosing instructions carefully.
- 3) All medications must be kept at the nurse's station. The only exception to this rule would be an extra inhaler accompanied by a physician's letter stating a necessity for carrying. In this case the inhaler must be with the camper at all times (fanny pack, etc.) Inhalers found apart from the camper will be returned to the nurse's station for the duration of the week. ***Please be assured that camp nurses are available by radio and can quickly deliver an inhaler to your camper if needed.***

Non-Prescription Medications:

- 1) All non-prescription medications (vitamins, dietary supplements, allergy meds, creams, etc.) must be in ***new, unopened packages*** on arrival to camp to be opened by the nurse upon first administering.
- 2) Any medications arriving in already opened containers or in unlabeled condition ***will not be accepted.***

Please bring all medications to camp in a ***gallon sized zipper sealed bag*** (use 2 if needed) with the camper's name written in permanent ink on the top front of the bag. Please ***label all equipment and non-prescription medications*** with the camper's name ***prior to arrival*** at camp. This will speed the check-in process.

We keep a good supply of basic medications should your camper need anything. Please do not send any of the following medications *just in case:*

Release of Liability

Prior to Camper's participation in Camp activities, I acknowledge that involvement of Camper in the Camp may involve risk of property damage and of personal injury, illness or even death of Camper, including, but not limited to the risks arising from transportation-related activities, recreational activities, accidents in the outdoors and rustic facilities, adverse weather conditions, and injuries and illness as a result of food-borne illnesses and allergic reactions. In addition, I understand that there may be other risks inherent in Camp activities of which I may not be presently aware.

By signing this Parental Consent and Release of Liability, I warrant the Camper is fully capable of safely participating in all Camp Activities, and I expressly assume all risks of Camper's participation, whether such risks are known or unknown to me at this time. I further generally release West Coast Honor Camp (WCHC) and its directors, officers, employees, volunteers, and agents, and other campers at the Camp, from any and all claims that I or Camper may have against any of them as a result of property damage or person injury, illness or death of Camper as a result of participation in Camp activities, whatever on or off Camp grounds. I agree that this release includes the ordinary, special and inherent risks described above, and other risks that I may not foresee or be aware of at this time. This Release of Liability is given on behalf of myself, Camper, and the heirs, family, estate, administrators, executors, personal representatives and assigns of me and Camper.

Consent to Medical Treatment

If Camper experiences an injury or illness, or has other medical needs, I authorize the Camp's employees, volunteers, and agents to make such arrangements for Camper's health and safety, including but not limited to first aid, emergency medical care, ambulance or other transportation to a hospital, medical office, or clinic, testing and examination, and hospital care, and other medical care and treatment (including dental care) as they feel are appropriate in the circumstances. I further agree that I am fully responsible to pay all charges and expenses relating to such care, transportation and treatment and I hereby fully release WCHC and its directors, officers, employees, volunteers and agents from any claims, including claims for medical charges, prescription costs and other expenses I might have as a result of such care, transportation and treatment. My signature below also serves to indicate my willingness for my Health Insurance Company (please provide details in the "Medical Information" section), to be billed for any and all medical fees and services should they be needed. I agree that I will pay all charges and expenses not covered by insurance.

Consent for Transportation

In the event of an emergency evacuation (all campers), and/or the High School Ministry Trip (High School Students only), I release and agree to hold harmless the owners/providers and operators of transportation vehicles from any and all liabilities or claims for personal injury, illness or death, as well as property damage and expenses of any nature whatsoever which may happen to my son/daughter that occurs within the effective dates stated above and/or while said child is participating in the above named program and its activities.

I understand that WCHC does not provide transportation to or from the Honor Camp program and do hereby take responsibility for either providing or arranging for transportation of Camper, and for ensuring that Camper will arrive and depart by the scheduled dates and times.

Other Releases and Acknowledgements

I understand that, while Camper is participating in Camp activities, photographs, film, audio recordings and videotape of Camper may be taken for use in brochures, videos, releases to the press, and various WCHC publications and other work product. I do hereby irrevocably grant WCHC permission to record, display and/or reproduce my child's name (first name only), likeness and voice on audio and/or video tape, film or other media, to use edit and otherwise modify such media at its discretion, to incorporate the media into any work product, and to use or authorize use of such media or any portion thereof in any manner or media or by any means, methods or technologies now know or hereafter to be known.

I will ensure Camper only brings clothing that adheres to the Camp Dress Code or similar policy included as part of this package or to be sent in the acceptance package. If Camper fails to abide by established rules, standards of conduct and/or Camp Dress Code, West Coast Honor Camp staff reserve the right to send Camper home. If it becomes necessary to send Camper home, I hereby agree to provide transportation or to make travel arrangements for Camper and to assume the cost of these expenses.

To the extent any provision of this document is found to be unenforceable, such provision shall be deemed severable and shall not affect the enforceability of any other portion of this document, and shall be reformed to be in compliance with the law and construed to most nearly reflect the intent of the parties.
